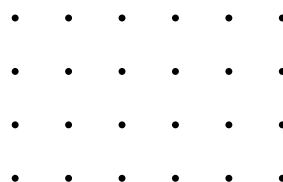

A dynamic private and public sector ecosystem likely possesses some challenges but also provides new opportunities to accelerate agroecological transitions via creating incentives and mobilizing investments, transparent and holistic metrics, and capacity building to contribute to more economically efficient, socially equitable, and environmentally friendly food systems.

This booklet presents the 21 companies identified through the collaboration between the Alliance of Bioersity International and CIAT through the PSii project PRIVATE SECTOR INCENTIVES AND INVESTMENTS (PSii) FOR CLIMATE CHANGE, RESILIENCE AND ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY of the Agroecological Transitions program and the CCITU (CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, INDUSTRY AND TOURISM OF UCAYALI), whose objective is to develop inclusive incentives structures and leveraging investments supporting the agroecological transition at multiple levels in Ucayali. This collaboration made it possible to organize the first Roadshow for agroecological transitions in Peru on 15 November 2023 in Pucallpa and brought together companies, associations and cooperatives selected in the framework of the Private Sector Incentives and Investments (PSii) project of the TRANSITIONS program.

You will find below a portfolio with the main characteristics of each company with the objective of establishing contacts or collaboration with impact investors and other financial institutions to move forward the agroecological transitions in the Ucayali region.



COOPERATIVA AGROINDUSTRIAL YARINACOCHA - COOPAY

1. Organization



The Yarinacocha Agroindustrial Cooperative - COOPAY started its activities in 2019 with the cultivation of fresh Camu-camu fruit. COOPAY currently has 90 members located in 14 villages in the district of Yarinacocha. In COOPAY, the relationship with its members, who supply them for the production of value-added products, is highly valued and cared for. The representative of COOPAY is Mr. Witle Córdova. He has sanitary registration and organic certification.

2. Financial contribution needed



COOPAY requires working capital estimated at **US\$130,000** to better commercialize and manage the stock of Camu-camu, as well as fixed asset financing to build a warehouse.

COOPERATIVA AGRARIA DE CACAO AROMÁTICO COLPA DE LOROS

1. Organization



Located in the district of Neshuya, province of Padre Abad, Colpa de Loros is strategically located within the agroforestry/ecological corridor of Ucayali. It started its activities in 2015. As of September 2022, Colpa de Loros's membership consisted of 515 cocoa producers. It is a cooperative organization that generates economic and social benefits for its members and community, through the profitable, sustainable and competitive production and direct export of fine aroma cocoa, applying the best agricultural, social, environmental and management practices. Its manager is Ernesto Parra y Guerra. It has organic certification, fair trade and sanitary registration.

2. Financial contribution needed



It requires estimated working capital of **US\$150,000** to increase its production and diversify its product portfolio through the processing of cocoa waste and by-products into, for example, cocoa nibs and cocoa distillate.

It was initially set up as a Central Association of Fine Aroma Cocoa Producers in Curimaná. It started its activities in 2010. It is located in the district of Curimaná. The companies to which its organic production is directed are in Italy, the country that imports 90% of its bean production. The remaining 10% of the conventional production is distributed to the national market. It has sanitary registration, organic certification of cocoa beans. Carlos Lenin Pérez Alván is the manager of the company.

It requires working capital estimated at **US\$150,000** to better commercialize and manage the stock, improve infrastructure and logistics in the agroecological transition framework.

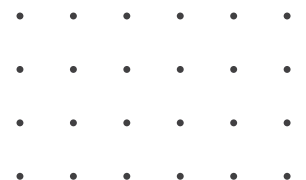

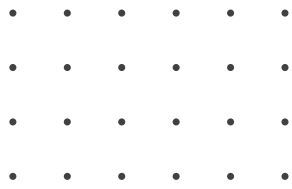
